I have harbored hatred and to this day still do. I am sorry God. I beat my breast, looking down at earth, and pour out my complaint before God, I am not worthy of your forgiveness.

Is this the love the Bible speaks of? I believe it is and all I can do is point to Jesus. I used to think I was loving but I realize from a friend of mine I am not. I know from the scornful looks and angry words I am not a friend that anyone would want. I am the scum around the bottom of the trash can that everyone wants to get rid of. I am that friend who works into lives and for what reason I don't want or don't realize I am like the tumor of cancer waiting to inflict pain. I think knowing this points to the very fact that the Apostle Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 13:3b "and though I give my body, that I be burned, and have not love, it profiteth me nothing." 1587 Geneva Bible.

I realize that it is not enough to pick up a homeless woman on the side of the road and give her lunch at McDonalds. It is not enough to give your all and do your all emptying out your wallet for a friend. It is not enough to try and rescue that friend devoting all of your time and all of your money to. To give the last thing you have trying and failing time and time again. Love is not enough?! Every blessing every giving is not enough. That is why I am not the picture of love. I am the picture of hate that everyone hates. I am sorry and I repent of the sin of what I have become.

You can loan out your favorite car and watch it be destroyed by someone you once respected. You can buy the best gifts for friends to later learn they were your enemies. You can rescue your best friend twice from a bad landlord but let me tell you this, "love just ain't enough!" The things we do in life don't even matter. Often in a relationship even with a friend, I don't like to lord over them. I have been told life is a game and sometimes you have to put your foot down. I'm not like that. In fact, I can't even stand that. I would love to lavish all my friends with gifts. I would love to see them healed. I would love all my friends to be young. I would love to give as much as I possibly could give to everyone. The problem is I can't: Now let me tell you why? Friends have come into my life, though they were actually my enemies, and they took everything. I gave and gave and gave because I love to give. I did not get in return. My life was smashed into the dust by those that wanted to send me to hell. Later my brain was wrecked making me slow and stupid by those wanting to see my fall. Not only did they see my fall, they watched me fail time and time again all the rest of my life. To them this was funny!

I have been watching my life in a downward tailspin heading in a freefall in a crash course to the ground. Only my God can fix it. Here's a poem that I think will make sense if this short book ever gets published. God the Father is its author I am just the pen. I entitled it the following:

You really should hate me...

If you only knew.

I've been there in your pain too.

I've cried for you.

My Son died for you.

I've wept by your side.

I've hurt when you cried.

I am the one you waited for.

I've come to your house I've knocked on your door.

You may be one I gave you a Bible or the Gospel of John.

You may be the one who trashed it as soon as I was gone.

You hated me all day and night.

I blessed you, but in your loss, you wanted to fight.

I was the song of drunkards, I was the song of your hate.

I was the one you laughed at and now you know your fate.

I did not want you to end.

I loved and cared for you as my best friend.

I went to your church and listened to what your pastor said.

He read modern Bibles, and preached the words in red.

When I tried to correct you, you earned your place in hell.

Money was your god, salvation wasn't key.

God finally came, saw, and won and has earned his victory.

When I prayed for you, you really didn't care.

I loved you anyway, but to one pastor I really am not fair.

The trumpet sounded, Christ came at last.

He rescued me from poverty and my insanity, and chains that bound me no longer clasp.

(Joe 2:27) And ye shall know^{H3045} that^{H3588} I^{H589} *am* in the midst^{H7130} of Israel,^{H3478} and *that* I^{H589} *am* the LORD^{H3068} your God,^{H430} and none^{H369} else:^{H5750} and my people^{H5971} shall never^{H3808} ^{H5769} be ashamed.^{H954}

Note the underlining is God plural. Here is the definition in God here in Hebrew.

H430

אלהים

'ēlôhî ym

el-o-heem'

Plural of [H433](#); *gods* in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme *God*; occasionally applied by way of deference to *magistrates*; and sometimes as a superlative: - angels, X exceeding, God (gods) (-dess, -ly), X (very) great, judges, X mighty.

Now let us take a look at the same verse in Joel 2:27 in the Latin Vulgate:

27 Et scietis quia in medio Israëel ego sum,

et ego Dominus **Deus** vester, et non est

amplius ;

et non confundetur populus meus in

æternum.

Here it is as if this Bible were hiding something since the word Deus is singular. I meditated on this verse for quite a while. I hate to point fingers, but I will, the Catholic Church did not need to know God the Father would come in the flesh in the end times. In singular here it can only refer to God as Jesus coming in the flesh which he did so 2000 years ago. Let us view Joel 2:27 in the most basic beginner Bible which is also the most common of ancient Bibles.

(Joe 2:27) And ye shall know that I *am* in the midst of Israel, and *that* I *am* the LORD your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.

See God, in English, takes on the same properties as LORD or Yahweh, being plural or singular. Sorry English is not the most perfect language. Greek uses Theos or plural and Spanish uses Dios with the same value. Only the Latin and Hebrew segregate whether God is plural or singular. Now let us look at the Bible in another light. Looking at Job 19:25 in the Latin Vulgate we see the following word “redemptor” without capitalization:

25 Scio enim quod **redemptor** meus vivit,

et in novissimo die de terra surrecturus

sum :

It is highly possible that God the Father did not want to let the Catholics know that our Father would be coming in end days. I consider the King James a beginner Bible since many things are hidden in it such as the word “redeemer,” redemptor in Latin, not pointing to God the Father. Here is how Job 19:25 is translated in the King James.

(Job 19:25) For I know *that* my redeemer liveth, and *that* he shall stand at the latter *day* upon the earth:

So, what is love? Smart Lookup in Word 2016 is simply an intense feeling of deep affection. If I had only one definition I would say that the truest picture I could paint of love has a name and that name is Jesus.

Chapter 2 Owning Up- It's all my fault!

It's all my fault I have finally concluded. I was the brutish man, I was the fool who hath said “no God!” I was the person who messed up relationship after relationship, and turned friends to enemies. I was the one who backstabbed and didn't return books, or divulged information to someone else. I was the jerk who couldn't keep appointments and I was the fool who burned bridges.

Twenty-five years ago, I had a one-night stand that turned into a relationship that I later destroyed. I was the one who messed up the relationship with the last girlfriend over 20 years ago. I was the heart breaker who once when thought I was in love, it was lust, and my own foolishness that I knew better. I was the one who told God I needed pornography because He wouldn't provide a wife. Thank God that chapter is over and it is too easy to want to pick back up again.

My mix-up and first major set back was with Dura-Crane. That was my first major set back buying a business that could not be ran no matter how hard I worked or how much money I tried to put back into it. It was an impossible situation I would have been better off simply walking away from. Later in a crash purposely caused by Todd Jessie Garton who was a warlock, put me out of business. To my own folly I never blamed Todd Jessie Garton, but rather blamed bad circumstances in an accident that “could have not been prevented.” In my folly I put all my eggs in one basket and bought into Todd's business with some of the money left from the insurance policy. It was my fault for not checking the paper work better and not doing business with another greedy man. In my folly of my first major business I found out I was under insured and the lost payee was Greg. WHAT A STUPID FOOL I WAS!!! I was good at business and the only thing I truly would have been successful with was RPG's or Role-Playing Games. Road Rebels was a flop and a half, but the perfected book, “The World of Total Chaos” was not. It was right on and had I published it, it would have been the best RPG ever written. That however, was not what God wanted, and I later after prison destroyed the last copy in existence along with any Road Rebels game books I had left. I destroyed that along with all my old idols including whatever music I had left from my “rock and roll” heathen days. When I penned “Turn Your Heart Over to Jesus” I had learned from careful studies that King Manasseh took his idols out of the temple but then did not

destroy them until King Josiah came along. Sometimes in life we cannot hang on to the old things that weigh us down from the past.

As 1997 rolled around that was when a 21-year curse began which I am just now seeing the light at the end of that tunnel. That was when I was a business partner to Todd and he was my “frienemy.” He was my best friend and I was his number one enemy. The book by Robert Scott, “Kill or be Killed” was written which does a decent job describing the stupid fool I had become. That was my folly and no blame of anyone else not Todd, my upbringing, the Marines, just me being a jerk. I broke my girlfriend’s heart, destroyed family relationships, and reaped a prison sentence that went from not so bad, to worse than ever: It was all a product of my own folly!

I failed again and again time after time and my folly did not seem to have a remedy. After prison it was pastor / caretaker Brock Dale Bernstein. He cleaned me out financially as did John from Nigeria in a bank scam which nearly sent me back to prison. After that it was “James Adam” (cheater man) that I donated over \$500.00 to in yet another scam. I failed in other areas with my money as well including SEO Search Engine Optimization techniques that took all my money. They were the “guru’s” with the knowledge, they were simply scammers and I was the fool who got roped in. I even paid into another scam that told me I could “get my google ads free!” It was all such a foolish nightmare I slipped into.

In a way though I do point the finger to both the warlock Todd Jessie Garton who cast spells on me and another warlock Darrel who claimed to be God and who also was my cellmate. I didn’t believe they could do it but they crushed my brain from normal operation and now I live with mental health issues for the rest of my life. Looking at this picture from another light, I feel Brock Dale Bernstein caused a lot of mental health issues that took over after he took tens of thousands of dollars from me and sent me back to prison for ten days. I really tried to forgive all of them and I really tried, but I just don’t care about them anymore and if they reap hell for eternity that is there “cup” they will have to bear for all of eternity. I tried to forgive them and in many places I did, but I’d be a liar if I didn’t tell the truth about how I really feel about those enemies. I’m sorry God, I know what your word says but even David in one of the Psalms penned these words; “do not I hate them, that hate thee oh LORD.” Three times in the book of Jeremiah God told Jeremiah don’t pray for these people. Well I prayed for them, I forgave them, but I just don’t care about them. I won’t shed a tear at their entrance to hell. If I’m there in hell with them then that’s God’s judgment. I have told God time and time again just blot me out of the book of life.

Chapter 3 Pointing Fingers!!!

A down syndrome lady I know uses her talents much better than most people that are higher functioning. She reads the King James Bible and interprets it; whereas another man, an elder in a SDA church can’t understand the Bible unless he reads it from the NLT modern Bible version. That Bible along with several other “easy reading versions” like the NASB are so watered down no man can get the true meaning.

I myself have a lot to learn. I take prayers from whomever I can. I feel if the right person prays a sincere prayer over me God will hear and he will bless me. Tonight, is August 17, 2018 and it is in the wee hours of the night. Tomorrow morning, I will have my prayers being prayed by some Scientologists I met here in the RV park where I live. God will hear my cries I have prayed to him for the past 20 years and answer them.

From a night I prayed my first prayer under my breath "God save us!" God heard from heaven and spared us three men from eternal damnation incarcerated in hell forever! Yes, that prayer was answered as a police officer in Portland Oregon was looking for us had his head pointed the other direction. Yes, we all deserved hell that very night. I was still a young man but I deserved eternal damnation and so did Todd and Norman Daniels III. Tonight, I talked to God for a good hour. I outlined the chapters of this book under a smoky summer night which I might finish tonight, for that is my goal, but I don't think it will be long enough to publish. I can only type 16 pages at tops in a day and that is if I don't run into writers' block. This is a short book but I gave it a lot of thought. I wanted to write something great but I am realizing now that great doesn't have to be 100 pages. I believe this book will be free with no copyright, but with true love. I thought to myself people write books all the time. They get professional looking covers, big name publishers, and even make it to the New York Times Bestsellers List. My purpose of this book is that it will be free and I want it to go from one email to the next. I want a book that proclaims love and is love, but that focuses on the main character who I deeply love and that is Jesus. I want this to go viral and reach people and let them know God the Father and His Son deeply love you. In the midst of ashes of destroyed homes and broken lives to let them know Jesus loves them.

(Isa 61:3) To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

(Isa 61:4) And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.

I've been unravelling a task that even the Father God Almighty comes down off his throne and He too works out our salvation. I feel God has given me certain wisdom that I asked for when I was locked up in prison. It is not a gift to be taken lightly and that gift plus a verse God gave me in a dream really made me take God a lot more seriously. In the dream I saw the word Ezekiel 33:3 first in flaming red then in flaming blue.

(Eze 33:3) If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet, and warn the people;

I am seeing a sword in the form of firestorms that believe me I understand why and how, but I think it's better you don't know all the facts. I will simply say Agenda 21 but I do not wish to crush hearts that are already broken, but rather to let you know these fires are the works of the Devil and not an act of God. God is love and there is no iniquity in him. Natural disasters are the by-product of sin. Sometimes the righteous are harmed, while perhaps the unrighteous seem to get away, but they really don't get away with anything. The wicked will crumble at the sound of the trumpet of God. That is the truth and it is no lie.

I have pointed a lot of fingers at different people, pastors, churches, and more. Sometimes in gentle rebuke other times with authority and power. Most of the time I have been rebuked and even kicked out of churches. Right now, I am churchless. While I love church, I can't stand religion or mis-leading doctrine. Religion is anything. Religion is not necessarily Christianity but it is typically the blame when a church heads the wrong direction.

Where do I go in this chapter? I tell you one place and that is to the Bible. I love God, Jesus and the Bible. I go where I need hope. If that means reading one verse a thousand times I'm there if it gives me hope. Often, we can't understand hope because we are too worried about the cares of this world that we busy our minds too much to read the Word of God let alone study it. We spend hours mulling over a credit card terms of service. When it comes to the insurance of a soul we want the easy way. Well I have been into the Bible, off and on, but usually very deep for 20 years. I have read the King James cover to cover many times though I feel not hardly enough. I read the boring parts, I've read the names of Chronicles, the city names, the dimensions of the Ark, and every word of the 66 books that comprise the King James Bible. I studied the back of the Strong's Exhaustive Concordance in Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek. I am mostly self-taught though I do admit I read a lot of books in my eight-year and seven-month prison stint. I used what I learned when I got my college degree an AA in General Education at Shasta College not in creating RPG's like I thought but rather working for God. I now write books which I still don't know if they too will be thrown in the trash or set to the side. I have learned one thing I am not as loving as I once thought I was sad to say and I do point the finger at myself.

I have pointed the finger at a lot of churches. I got mad when I went to Little Country Church and found out they sell every Bible under the sun yet don't sell one King James Version. Even at that I am not super-excited about the King James and wondered why I wasn't given the King James 1611 in the first place but then I realized a few things. The King James makes good use of modern punctuation, though you have to really dig deep to see capitalization changes. I love the 1560 Geneva Bible, the 1541 Great Bible, the 1568 Bishop's Bible and the 1388 Wycliffe. I see a wonderful flavor in all of these Bibles and they bring me great hope. I'm sorry to say but modern Bibles are lacking. I say this as I too started out with a Free on the Inside NIV Bible as well as my NIV Bible that with lots of learning I traded both in for the King James. I found the King James a wonderful Bible as it meshes perfectly with either the Strongest Strong's which I don't like as much as the Strong's Exhaustive Concordance an older concordance. Why am I speaking all this boring stuff in a book called "Love?" Because I love you and I don't like to see people tricked by bad translations written by people trying to deceive you, which is no different than our government's deception by contrived fires that the wicked control. Here I am not talking about the firefighters that are in the trenches because I have been there too in the White's Boots on the fire line.

One thing I don't want is for a person to throw out the NIV or NKJV or whatever modern Bible because I disappointed you. I just want to somehow change a person's thoughts to meditating on the Bible even if it is a Billy Graham NKJV or a Free on the Inside Bible. I mean read whatever Bible that is in front of you but don't hesitate. I've read the Bible enough times to see that ancient Bibles are superior to modern Bibles. If you ever do get interested in an ancient Bible a good site to get started on is www.bibles-online.net

I have a second chance in life. Lynn Noyes who I later learned things about that I understand now is paying for a crime she won't have a chance outside of prison. She will live out all her years, the rest of

her life, behind bars. She has no second chance nor does Norman Daniels III and I do understand why and I really can't sympathize with either of them. As for Todd Jessie Garton he reaped what he sowed.

(Gal 6:7) Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

What few failed to realize was that Carole Ann Holman was my friend. I mourned her loss too. One pathetic loser had to have her killed over the fact Carole beat us both in tennis at the same time us against her over and over again. What a male shovenistic fool! But then who am I to speak I thought he was a Marine but never even earned the title recruit.

In loving anyone we have to own up.

(1Jn 1:9) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

I have created books, websites, poetry, and love gifts not to brag or roll out the red carpet but rather to say I am sorry for my part in a crime I never wanted to commit. Had I known the truth Todd would have ended up in the grave and Carole and her son James would be alive today. What I did listen to a fool is the opposite of what love is.

Love is listening to a wife and helping her out of her problems. Love is being called a bad friend, and admitting you are in the wrong when every fiber of your body wants to say "not!!" It's not what we do in life, often it's what we don't do. You can have a friendship but if you fail at one point you have failed all. That is the way God is too.

(Jas 2:10) For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one *point*, he is guilty of all.

A man can buy a thousand roses, lavish a thousand dinners but I tell you what if you fail the wrong point beware!!! God really isn't any different. If you reject Jesus Christ you are guilty of all points not just one. It's more than just that though. You can spend your entire life as a Christian thinking well I saw the gulf and I confessed Jesus now I'm at the other side and nothing can take that away. Those are dangerous grounds. I can't stand up against a hundred air-conditioned RV's that invite you to accept Christ. I mean who am I? I am nothing. All I am is a man that studied the right Bible and spent enough time going over the right verses to tell you love is a relationship and God is not stupid. You can divorce God just as easy if not easier than divorcing your wife. I know from experience that from a few foolish words spoken in anger against God can equal eternal damnation. I did this. I divorced God with careless words spoken in vain. I was a fool and nothing could save me except repenting before the same people that I had spoken "God doesn't answer prayers." I assure you he does and God taught me a big, big lesson. I was an inch from hell but God forgives sinners. I know what I faced. I went to church and I said the sinner's prayer but that could not save me.

(Rom 6:23) For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

My wages of sin were death but God saved me through his Son Jesus Christ. After my sin I called on the name of the LORD to be saved because almost every night through my entire jail and prison sentence I went to hell in dreams and visions.

(Rom 10:13) For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

I found out real quick that the words I said years ago in jail did not make a difference. I belonged to the following category of people until I confessed my sin before God and before men. Lucky for me God did not allow one person to leave the unit until I repented to all of them. God gave me one full week to think about what I did wrong.

(Mat 7:21) Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

(Mat 7:22) Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

(Mat 7:23) And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

The truth is you can lose your salvation and despite a certain pastor's folly it is Christ plus. Two pieces of bread do not make a sandwich. It's all the ingredients in-between the bread that make the sandwich what it is. This I think is one reason Christians don't take me seriously. We are all too busy on the sidelines warming the pews rather than to get into the game and get our hands and feet in the mud. So too goes with being a servant of the King Most High. Yes, everyone gets the message but not all get it at the right time. It is the folks engaged in the battle that hear the tune of war and strike first. Yes, I am a former US Marine. The Bible is a book of war and for those who have read it are prepared and you get a message. It wasn't until several hundred times I got this message down. All the people get warned in the end but it is the lowly, the meek, the humble that get the message sometime before the shofar sounds.

(Joe 2:28) And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

(Joe 2:29) And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

The bondservants or slaves get the message in the right time "in those days" not afterward as the fools get the message. All flesh gets the message but they don't get the message ahead of time. God warns those paying attention and I do believe there will be a sign. It won't come from a church, not from this book, not from a friend but I believe God will give one final warning to God's children. When you see this warning its where the rubber meets the road and it is time to get right with God. Right now, it's 3:31 am and I won't sleep tonight. I have to go to the food drive in a few hours and there is no time to sleep. I'm coming to the realization I might need an hour of sleep if I can even shut my brain down at this point. I realize I have to get this done but my mind and fingers don't type fast enough.

Chapter 4 Witnessing & The Rejection!

Sometimes we may get the idea that working for God is not necessary. Whether we feel the work is too hard, unnecessary, unrewarding, or perhaps even embarrassing; I assure you that you are wrong. Working for God is rewarding and God loves a cheerful giver.

(2Co 9:7) Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, *so let him give*; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

Even works are important but if you say works are necessary you are often deemed as a cult. I guess I am a cult. The whole thing is even Jesus stated that He rewards based on your works.

(Rev 22:12) *And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.*

I don't understand what people and churches alike are saying. They tell you not to do good works just like they tell you don't read the Apocrypha and they are serious. I have heard all kinds of things regarding works. It is not necessary they say. I've heard people say Christianity unlike any other religion does not require works.

When you say yes to Jesus you are hired, but then after the love grows cold, as I have often seen; you decide not to go to work. Even evangelism is an important work, but often we won't do the work we should be doing. For us it's often easier to sit on the sidelines while the players are out in the field. Church is the same way: A pastor can feed you all kind of non-sense from a corrupt modern Bible and just expect you to sit there and take it. I am proactive. (Mat 5:11) *Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.*

(Mat 5:12) *Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.*

Maybe we all could do better. I am betting God wants better instead of "good enough." Evangelizing is hard for me. I have carried on seemingly good conversations and while speaking all is good, but as soon as I mention the word Jesus I get the riot act. It is not that I am trying to instill anger its just I want to give you the option of finding out about Jesus Christ who is our LORD and Savior. After all what are you in the sight of God. As for me the language I use is "worm."

(Job 17:14) I have said to corruption, Thou *art* my father: to the worm, *Thou art* my mother, and my sister.

(Isa 41:14) Fear not, thou worm Jacob, *and* ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Maybe we all need a class on humility. After all God does not want us proud self-delivering fools.

(Mat 5:5) **Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.**

(Jas 4:6) But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

(1Pe 5:5) Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all *of you* be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

I'm not sure if I present the gospel in the wrong light, if it is because I am the wrong look to be delivering the package I try to submit, or if I just don't have the right words. Whatever the cause I just don't get much appreciation for trying to save souls. It just plain hurts a lot of times because I consider the King that I serve to be important and a lot of people seem to hate him. WOW!!!

(1Sa 15:23) For rebellion *is as* the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness *is as* iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from *being* king.

LORD I do not intend to kick someone out, so they can be homeless and, on the street, and I forgive me please for not being more forceful but I have a heart of compassion on human beings. Chapter 7 Churches & Bibles

How about all of us go to Acts 8:37. I will include it below in case it is not in your Bible.

(Act 8:37) And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Or what about knowing God is wise? Well believe it or not a lot of Bibles exclude the word “wise” making God out to be a fool!

There are myriads of changes to verses adding, subtracting and changing in order to have enough changes to get their version of the Bible copyrighted.

For more changes do your own homework and find out what has been taken out of the New Testament alone. While the NKJV or New King James may seem to have all the verses in the New Testament many changes have been made within this Bible making it a very corrupt version. Let us take a look at the following verses in the NKJV:

Joel 2:25 New King James Version (NKJV)

²⁵“So I will restore to you the years that the swarming ^[a]locust has eaten,
The crawling locust,
The consuming locust,
And the chewing locust,
My great army which I sent among you.

- a. **Joel 2:25** Exact identity of these locusts unknown

New King James Version (NKJV)

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(Joe 2:25) And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.

There is a reason that each form of destroyer is different and it is different in the Hebrew as well. It is because each destroyer takes on a different job at destroying your crops so that the destruction is complete.

Take a look at another verse from the NKJV.

Zechariah 3:5 New King James Version (NKJV)

⁵And I said, "Let them put a clean turban on his head."

So they put a clean turban on his head, and they put the clothes on him.
And the Angel of the LORD stood by.

New King James Version (NKJV)

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(Zec 3:5) And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.

I can see Jesus wearing a fair miter which in Hebrew is a crown but certainly not a turban. Do your homework and use the site I am giving below:

[Amo 3:14](#) That in the day that I shall visit the transgressions of Israel upon him I will also visit the altars of **Bethel**: and the horns of the altar shall be cut off, and fall to the ground.

[Amo 4:4](#) Come to **Bethel**, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and bring your sacrifices every morning, *and* your tithes after three years:

[Amo 5:5](#) But seek not **Bethel**, nor enter into Gilgal, and pass not to Beersheba: for Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, and **Bethel** shall come to nought.

[Amo 5:6](#) Seek the LORD, and ye shall live; lest he break out like fire in the house of Joseph, and devour *it*, and *there be* none to quench *it* in **Bethel**.

[Amo 7:10](#) Then Amaziah the priest of **Bethel** sent to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, Amos hath conspired against thee in the midst of the house of Israel: the land is not able to bear all his words.

[Amo 7:13](#) But prophesy not again any more at **Bethel**: for it *is* the king's chapel, and it *is* the king's court.

PS If you want to call it Bethel or i-Bethel it does matter. The little “i” in front of Bethel took me a very long time to figure out. Well “I” in Greek means “ego” kind of like “egocentric,” or “egomania.” Bethel does not have a good Bible history though the Hebrew definition is “house of God.” If you have done your homework as I have you will see that golden calves were erected in both Bethel and Dan. Read the Old Testament and look it up in your Strong’s Concordance which you may do in the Alabaster House in Bethel and you can even look the verses up in a King James 1611 which is on a table on the south west wall of the Alabaster House. Let us first examine a little history.

(1Ki 12:32) And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that *is* in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. The feast ordained by King Jeroboam was supposed to be Sukkot and it happens on the 7th month and the 15th day though this wicked King made it a month later. That is not okay with God.
